The University of Eswatini in partnership with the Department of Research Science Technology and Innovation under the Ministry of ICT (and other National Institutions) will host the Research & Innovation Management Symposia under Strengthening Research & Innovation Management (SRIM II) in SADC on the 19th - 20th June 2024 (Happy Valley Hotel). The Country Symposia is an activity under the SRIM II programme envisioned to be a two-day hybrid (virtual and in-person) event that brings together key actors across various national and international research and innovation (R&I) ecosystems to engage on key issues, challenges and opportunities within the respective national R&I ecosystems.
